Student Performance for Fall 2017 Compared to Data from New First Time Freshmen Fall 2007 to Fall 2011.

Act Composite = 16 Only

Outcomes for Fall 2017 were examined for the ACT composite of 16 only. A total of 155 students were included in the examination with 72 of them being new first time freshmen (FF).¹ The outcomes are detailed in the table below.

⁵ Recommended courses is based on the advising worksheet for Fall 2017. Note that there were several instances of advisors entering one course, "*", "class", or "educ" providing little guidance to the student.
